

"Etna Rosso 'San Nicolo' DOC

Appellation: Etna DOC

Region: Sicily

Grapes: 80% Nerello Mascalese, 20% Nerello Cappuccio

Alcohol: 13%

Age of vines: Planted in 1990

Single Vineyard: Contrada Monte San Nicolo

Vinification: 10-12 days on the skins, Malolactic fermentation in stainless steel.

Aging: Aging in small 225 litre barrels for 18 months before bottling.

Vineyard Location: Commune di Trecastagni, Catania Sicily

Nose: Nose: Rose hips, red cherries, rose petals Mouth: Pomegranate, firm acidity, lithe tannins, elegant San Nicolo is a half-hectare parcel located in the Contrada Ronzini vineyard which has been in the Biondi family's hands for decades. The vines are ungrafted and come from the south east area of Mount Etna.
